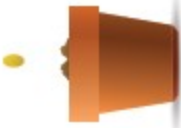




COMMUNITY GARDEN + EDIBLE FOREST APPLICATION PROCESS



STEP 1

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST
Group/individual expresses written or verbal interest to the Kingston Community Gardens Network (KCGN) coordinator at gardens@lovingspoonful.org or 613-507-8848.

STEP 2

SITE APPROVAL
The City determines if the proposed site is viable and suitable for growing food for human consumption.

STEP 3

APPLICATION
An application to request to establish an edible forest OR community garden is submitted to the KCGN coordinator. The support of ten community members (garden) or three community members (forest) is required.

STEP 4

DESIGN PLAN
Developed in consultation with the KCGN coordinator and City staff, the design plan shows the proposed location and configuration of the community garden/edible forest on the property.

STEP 5

NEIGHBOURHOOD CONSULTATION
The KCGN coordinator and City staff help the applicant organize a consultation to inform and determine support from neighbouring residents on the proposed location and design.

STEP 6

APPROVAL AND AGREEMENT
If the conditions meet City standards, approval is granted. The City prepares an agreement to be signed by the group's representative and a new community garden/edible forest is founded.
